Crime Watch

Crimes in St. Mary's Park are down 18% when comparing January '96 to January '95 with a big reduction in auto-related crimes. However, the park did experience 3 incidents of petty theft from locked autos on Murray and the 300 block of Justin. There was also a grand theft from the St. Mary's Rec Center, a report of a stolen automobile on Agnon Ave. and one incident of malicious mischief/vandalism on Justin.

Past President Bill Fosset is volunteering to get a "Neighborhood Watch" program organized in the Park. Stay tuned for more details.

Promised Stop Signs in St. Mary's Park Still Under Consideration

Last year, past President Bill Fossett and Guido Guinasso of the Executive Board began talks with the City Traffic Engineer to get stop signs on College at Murray and Justin at Genebern. Our new Vice President George Chen will continue to monitor the issue. According to the City Traffic Engineer, Bill Kimberly, the Department is going to make a complete study of the traffic flow in St. Mary's Park, once PG&E has completed their work on the gas lines. In the meantime, we feel that the traffic flow directions in our park are okay, except the speeding problems along College, Genebern and Justin. George will keep in close communication with the City Traffic Department to see that this study happens and to let them know what the residents of St. Mary's Park want. Please come to the monthly meetings with any suggestions or comments you have about traffic flow in the Park.


